DAF's New CF and LF Euro 6 Vehicles

The DAF CF Euro 6 will begin production in the middle of this year and has been developed for a wide number of applications, ranging from regional transportation to heavy construction. The DAF LF Euro 6 is designed for distribution and urban delivery and will begin production in the fourth quarter. These DAF Euro 6 models feature a durable, lightweight chassis, fuel-efficient drivelines, an enhanced aerodynamic exterior and spacious interiors. The reliable, fuel-efficient PACCAR MX-11 engine will be available in DAF's CF and XF Euro 6 vehicles this fall. The PACCAR MX-11 is a 10.8-liter engine with power outputs ranging from 290 to 440 horsepower and a torque range up to 1,500 lb.-ft. The PACCAR MX-11 adds to the existing PACCAR family of engines that are available for DAF's Euro 6 vehicles, which range from the 4.5-liter PACCAR PX-5 engine to the 12.9-liter PACCAR MX-13 engine.

PACCAR is a global technology leader in the design, manufacture and customer support of high-quality light-, medium- and heavy-duty trucks under the Kenworth, Peterbilt and DAF nameplates.
